NEW TESTAMENT COMMENTARIES

Purpose: To highlight the best two or three commentaries on the New Testament books.

Divisions: Commentaries may be classified roughly into three groups: (1) Critical, (2) Exegetical, and (3) Expository. (These may appear in combinations, i.e. a critical commentary is frequently exegetical.) These classifications generally answer the following questions: (1) Critical--What is the best text, and what does it say? (2) Exegetical--What does it mean? This will involve context, history, grammar, etc. (3) Expository--What does it mean to me or, How may it be applied to a life situation?

Terms: Greek text means that the Greek text is used as a basis for comment. English text means an English translation, either standard or the commentator's own, is the basis for comment. Frequently, however, the English text is used, but it is based on knowledge of the Greek.

English and American editions: American editions are usually more expensive and always better in quality. The print will usually be larger; the binding stronger; the format more presentable; and the paper of better quality. But the English editions are less expensive! Henry, Carl F. H., The Protestant Dilemma. Grand Rapids, Michigan: Wm. B. Eerdmans Publishing Company, 1948. A good analysis of contemporary theology by a noted Evangelical theologian.

Clark, Gordon H., Religion, Reason and Revelation. Philadelphia, Pennsylvania: Presbyterian and Reformed Publishing Company, 1961. A recent work by an outstanding Evangelical thinker.

Carnell, Edward J., The Theology of Reinhold Niebuhr. Grand Rapids, Michigan: Wm. B. Eerdmans Publishing Company, 1951. A good analysis by an able evangelical theologian.

Henry, Carl F. H., Fifty Years of Protestant Theology. Boston: W. A. Wilde Company, 1950. A good brief survey.

Orr, James, The Christian View of God and the World. Grand Rapids, Michigan: Wm. B. Eerdmans Publishing Company, 1947. This book is somewhat out of date but it is still a great and inspiring presentation. Basically evangelical in viewpoint.

Clark, Gordon H., A Christian View of Men and Things. Grand Rapids, Michigan: Wm. B. Eerdmans Publishing Company, 1952. A very valuable work by one of our outstanding evangelical thinkers.

Carnell, Edward J., An Introduction to Christian Apologetics. Wm. B. Eerdmans Publishing Company, 1948.

_____, A Philosophy of the Christian Religion.

Eerdmans, 1952. An excellent work.

Warfield, Benjamin Breckinridge, The Inspiration and Authority of the Bible. Philadelphia: The Presbyterian and Reformed Publishing Company; one of the most able defenses of the inspiration of the Bible ever written.

Burtt, Edwin A., Types of Religious Philosophy. New York: Harper and Brothers Publishers, 1939. A valuable examination of various types of religious philosophy with a very able summary of the basic assumption of each position. However, it must be noted that this man is a Humanist.

Bronstein, Daniel J. and Schulweis, Harold M., Approaches to the Philosophy of Religion. Englewood Cliffs, New Jersey: Prentice, Inc., 1954. An interesting presentation of a diversity of viewpoints on problems of great importance. Selections are taken from noted thinkers, past and present.
