



# Rev. C. C. Beatty, Rites Set Retired College For Rev. Dean, Dies C. C. Beatty

The Rev. C. C. Beatty, 80, retired dean of the Northwest Bible College, Seattle, died last night

Jan. 9, 1951

in a hospital. Mr. Beatty was born in Knox, Ind. He attended the Northwest Bible and Training School, Minneapolis, and the University of Greensboro, N. C.

He spent 50 years in the ministry, including 25 years in bible school work.

He was field superintendent of the North Central Bible Institute in Minneapolis for a number of years and later dean of the school. He was dean of the Northwest Bible College here for 15 years and retired two years ago as dean emeritus. He was an elder of Calvary Temple. His home was at 802 E. 77th St.

Surviving are his wife, Hattie L., and a daughter, Genevieve Beatty, Seattle.

Funeral services for the Rev. Charles Clifford Beatty, 80, dean emeritus of the Northwest Bible College, who

died Tuesday in a hospital, will be held at 1 o'clock Saturday afternoon in the Calvary Temple, with burial in Acacia.

Representatives of the Northwest District Assemblies of God, Northwest Bible College and the Calvary Temple will take part in the services. Arrangements are under the direction of the Green Lake Funeral Home.

Mr. Beatty was born in Knox, Ind., and had been in the ministry for 50 years. He was ordained in the Baptist denomination in 1901 and held pastorates for a number of years and conducted evangelistic campaigns.

Mr. Beatty helped to found the Northwest Bible College here and was dean of it for 15 years, retiring two years ago. He also helped to organize the North Central Bible Institute in Minneapolis and served as dean there until he came to Seattle. He was assistant superintendent for the North Central District of the Assemblies of God in Minnesota and worked also as field superintendent in the district.

Mr. Beatty was an elder of Calvary Temple and assisted in the Sunday services. His home was at 802 E. 77th St.

He is survived by his wife, Hattie L., and a daughter, Genevieve Beatty, of Seattle.
