ALL WOMEN STUDENTS!!! Don't forget to sign up for Intramural Volleyball. Today is your last day. Off campus sign up in the SUB.

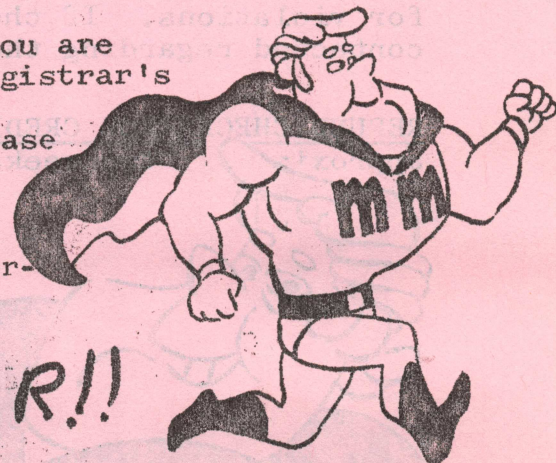
