PRE-REGISTRATION APPOINTMENTS -

We are now taking appointments for spring quarter registration in Bronson Hall. SENIORS AND GRADUATING SOPHOMORES WILL HAVE PRIORITY FOR REGISTRATION ON FEB. 13, PROVIDED they sign up for an appointment by no later than Wednesday, Feb. 8. ANYONE can make an appointment to register for the first day of registration (Feb. 13) after Feb. 8th. REGISTRATION ON FEB. 13 WILL BE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. No appointments will be taken after Feb. 10.

Be sure you come in for an appointment if there are specific classes you need to graduate, because all classes are filled on a first-come-first-served basis.

Registration appointments will only be needed on February 13. From Feb. 14 - 21, it will be open registration. After Feb. 21, late registrations will be assessed a \$10 late fee.

STUDENT ACCOUNTS - A 6% carrying charge is added to all unpaid balances. 3% will be cancelled for payments received by tomorrow, - Feb. 2. As of Feb. 3, no carrying charge will be cancelled. Save \$'s by paying now.
