Professor Ming's office.

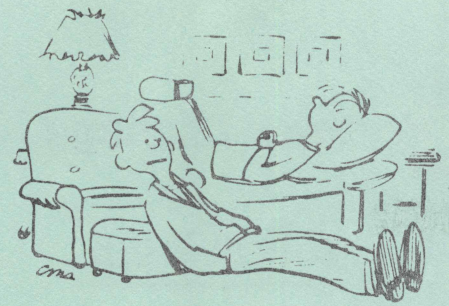
Students from Montana: There will be a
