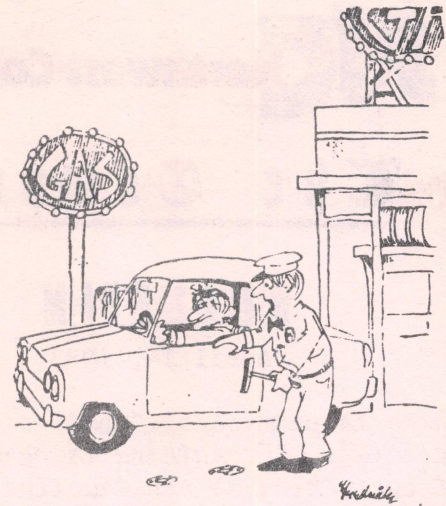
IT'S SPRING BANQUET TIME !!!
