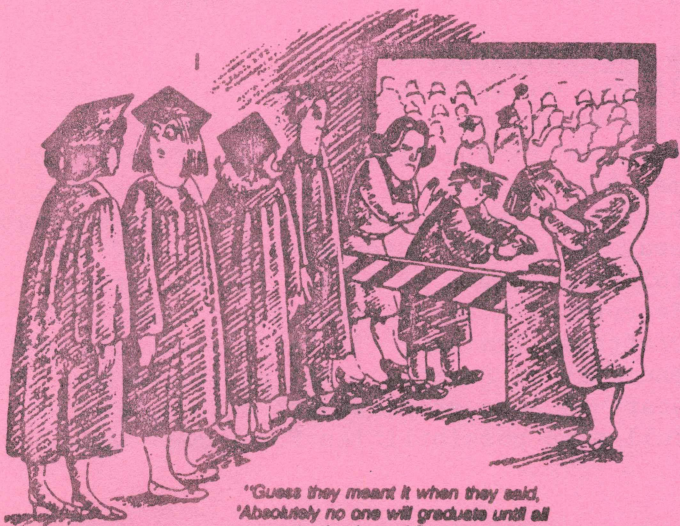
## ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT !!!
