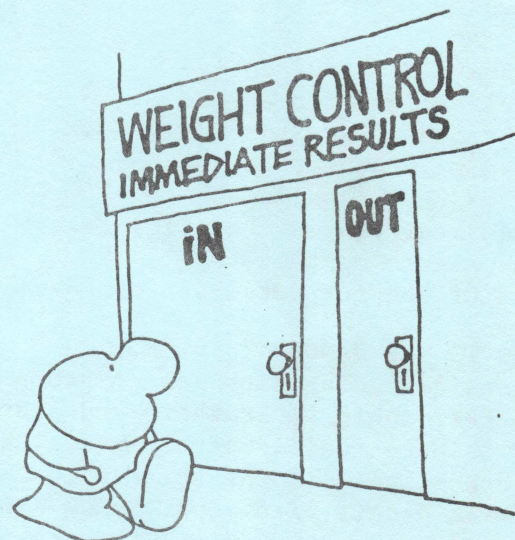

## EVANGELIST INTERNSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

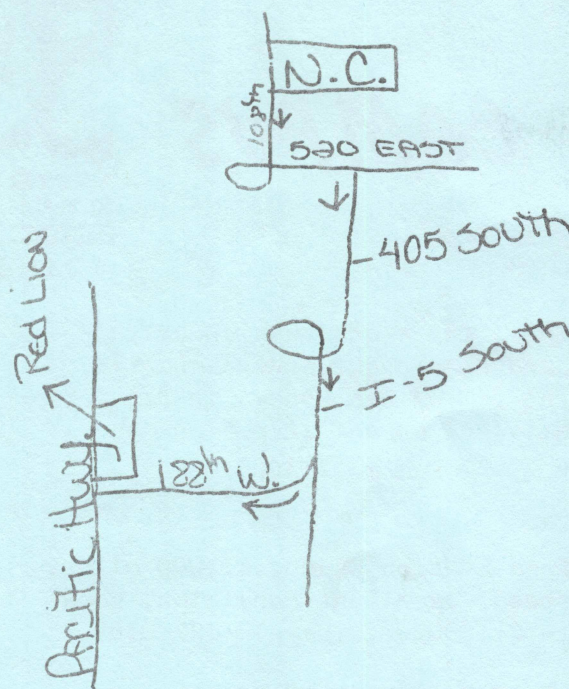
