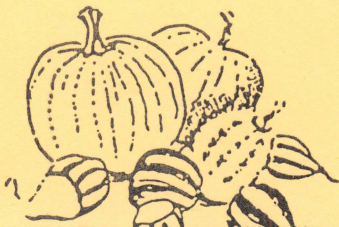
The Colorado D-Cap, Ray Smith, will be taking Colorado students to Pizza on Thursday, November 29th. Sign up at the reception desk.
