MONEY ANNOUNCEMENT - Tuition Credits (formerly called "Discounts") are being <u>adjusted</u> in the following manner for all students (new and returning) beginning Fall 1992:

A 15% Tuition Credit will be extended to <u>Assemblies of God</u> ministers, missionaries, chaplains, and full time administrators/teachers in K-12 Christian schools (and spouses, dependents).
