

Charmian Jacobson Buck 1993 Alumnus of the year

Charmian Jacobson Buck matriculated in Northwest Bible Institute in September 6, 1935. During her college days she was involved in student leadership as secretary-treasurer of the Missionary society and as Associated Editor of the school magazine during the same year.

She graduated from the college as a member of the 1938 Lifesavers' Class. It was after this when she was married to the Reverend Roland Buck, a classmate at the college.

Charmian shared in her late husband's ministry which became almost legendary at the Boise Central Assembly Christian Life Center over an extended period of time. Their ministry has been the subject of at least two books concerning the supernatural visitations that became part of their ministry in Boise. Her late husband, Roland and his brother, the Reverend Walter Buck teamed as spiritual emphasis week speakers shortly before Roland's decease.

When her husband was taken home to be with the Lord Charmian's indomitable spirit caused her to not only look beyond the veil of human sorrow but she took up the torch where her husband left off in the pastoral leadership of the Christian Life Center in Boise, where today she, together with her son, Ted A. Buck continue to the present time.
