#### Directions to the Northwest College Campus: From North or South on Interstate 5 -

Travel to Interstate 405. Exit at #17 (NE 70<sup>th</sup> St). Go west (left) on NE 70<sup>th</sup> Street towards Lake Washington to  $108^{th}$  Ave. NE. Turn left on  $108^{th}$  and proceed about one mile to the campus. The front entrance to the college will be on your left.

#### From Seattle -

Go east on Highway 520 (Evergreen Point Bridge) to Kirkland/Bellevue area. Exit at the first Kirkland exit which is Lake Washington Blvd northbound (southbound is Bellevue Way). Proceed north on Lake Washington Blvd to the first stop light which is Northup Way. Turn right at Northup Way and go to 108<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE. Turn left onto 108<sup>th</sup> and go over a mile to the front entrance of Northwest College (on your right).
