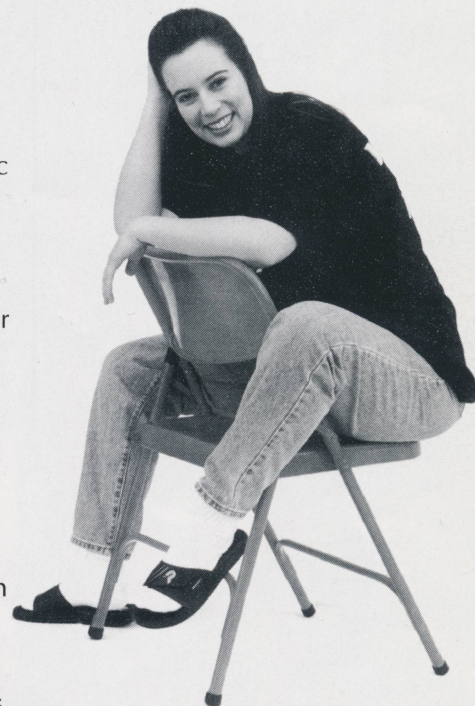
ACTIVITIES FOR YOU WITHIN...

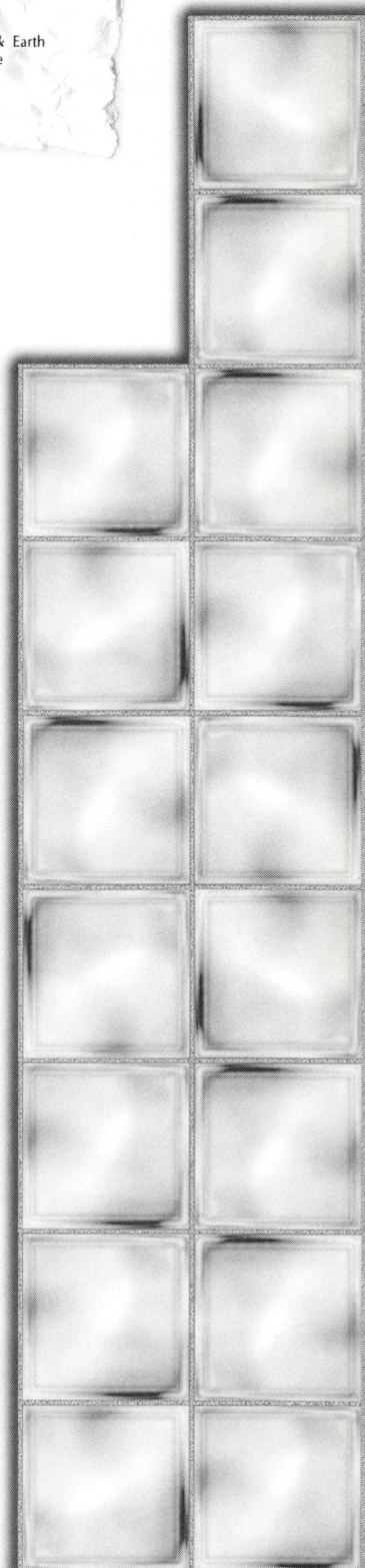
