PASSOVER CELEBRATION

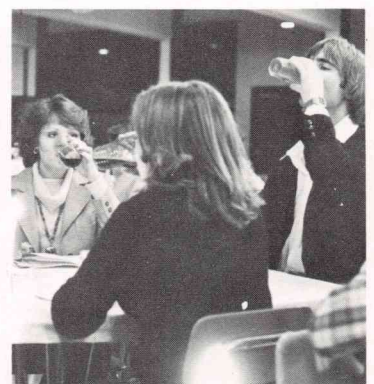
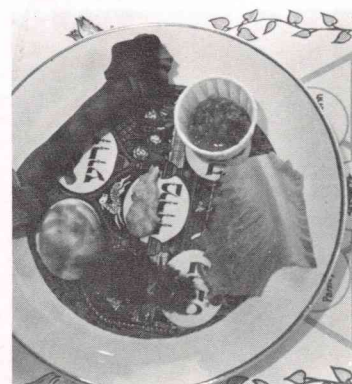
"Blessed art thou, O Lord our God, Ruler of the universe,

It was definitely an educational experience. And a wonderful night of fellowship, praise and worship.

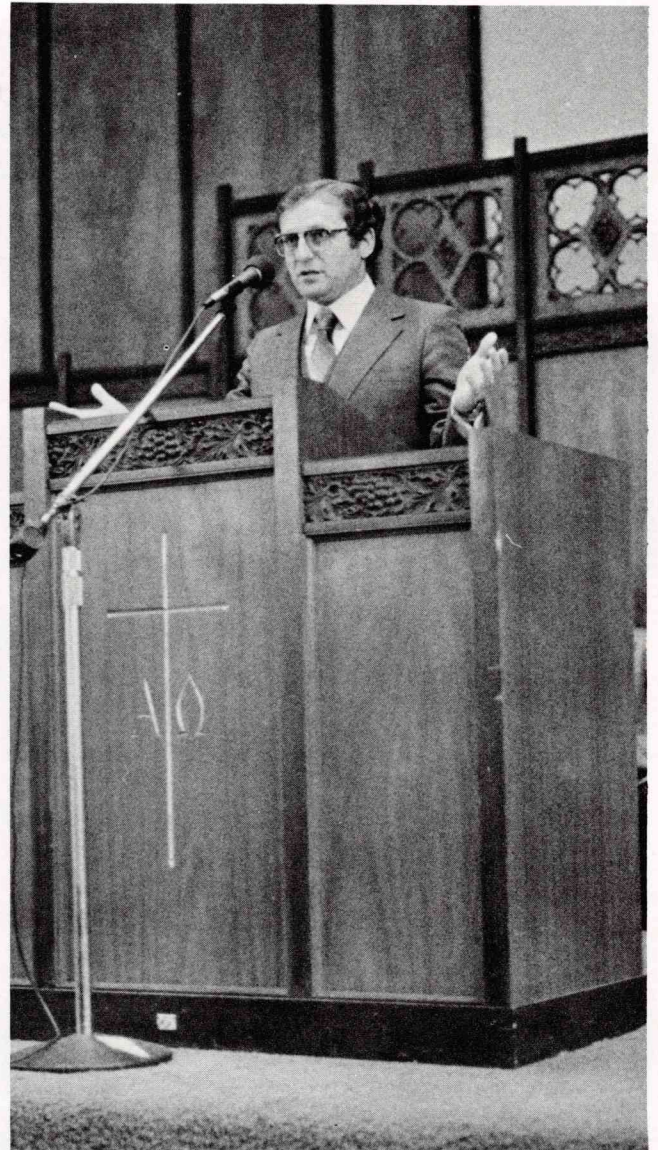
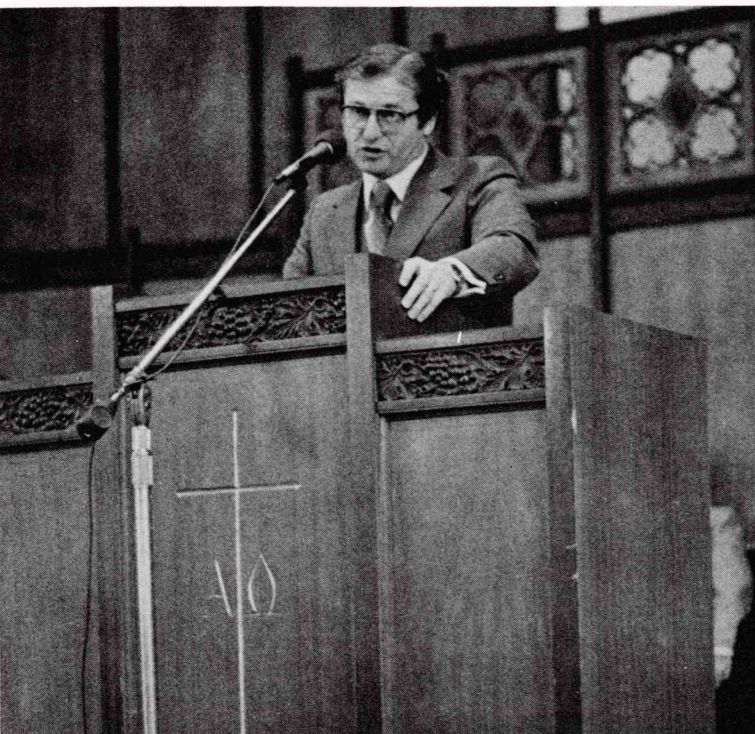

DEED BURNING

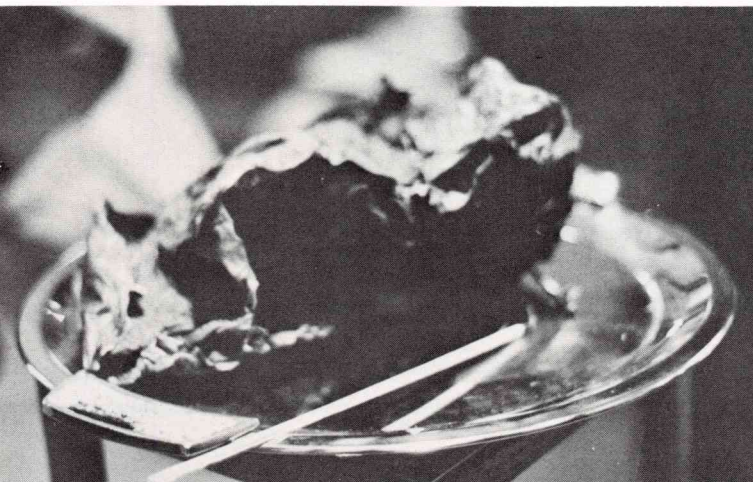

Until finally in 1979, twenty years had past and the deed was handed over to us. Making the property completely ours, with no restrictions. A great day for celebration, for new developments could be started.

A major activity of the Lay Council is the annual funding project—usually the launching of a major funding drive of the campus development.



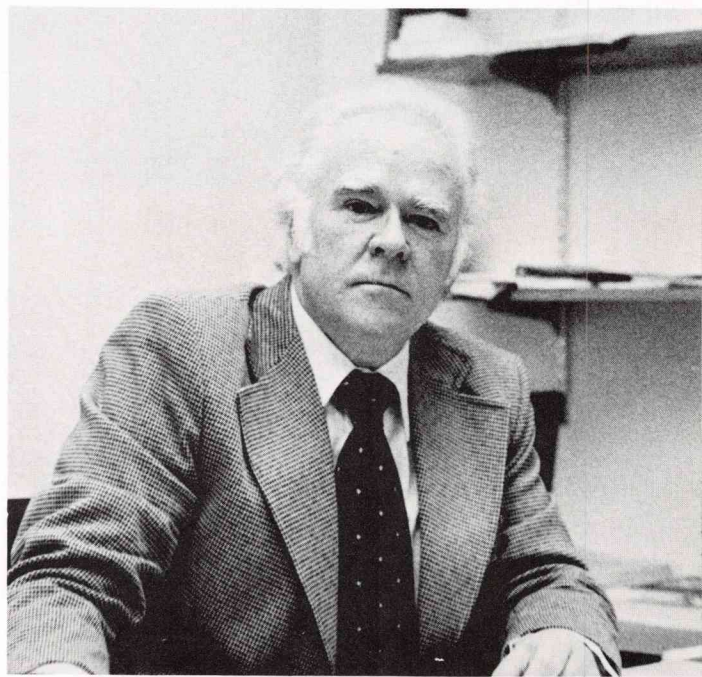
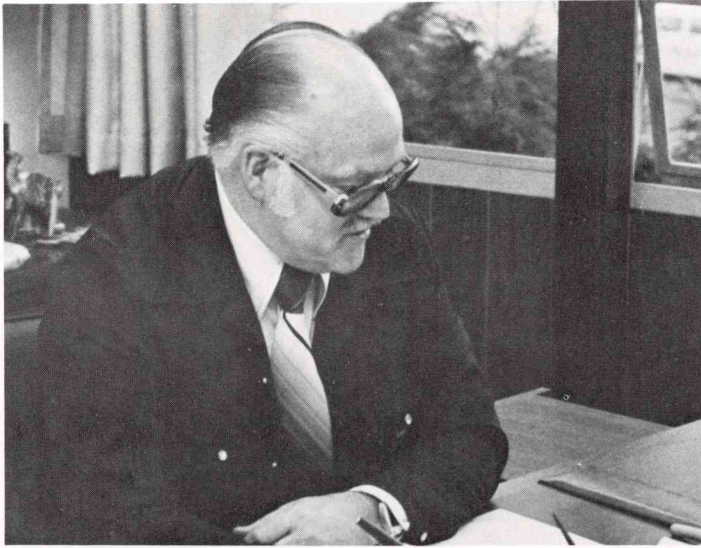

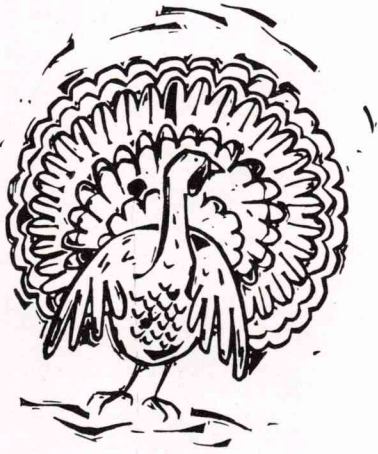




OPERATION TURKEY:

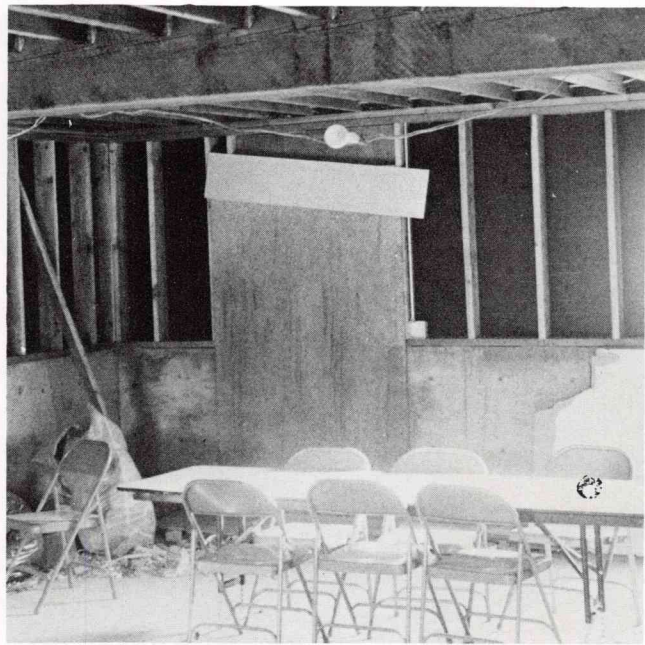

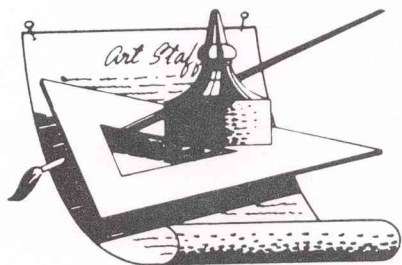

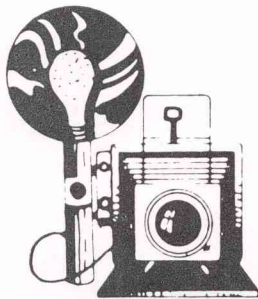




ADVISORS

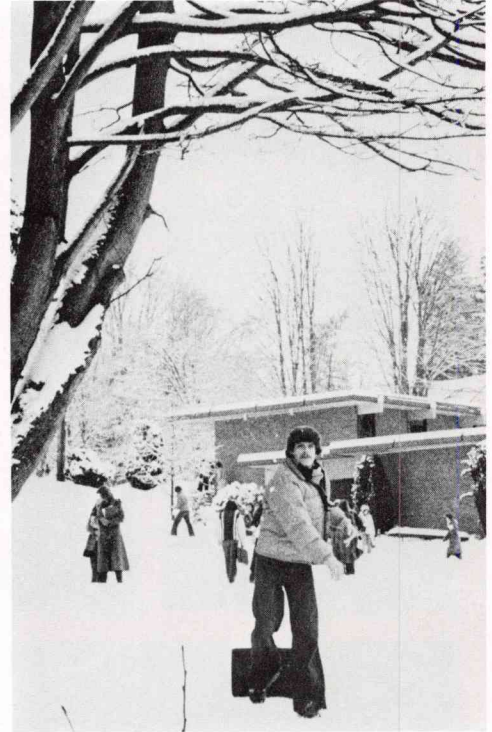
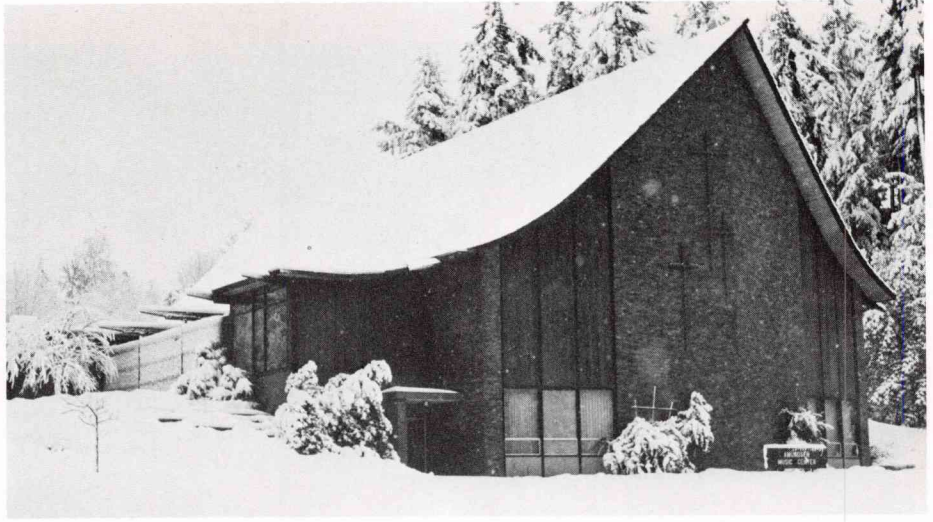
Intramural Football
