# DEDICATION

A college can only be as effective as its administration is efficient. The institution may have knowledgeable professors, an impressive library, and a convenient campus, but unless that institution is given solid leadership, it must ultimately fail in fulfilling the challenge that faces it: to provide an adequate education for Christian servants in a changing world.

Northwest College has been blessed with this kind of leadership in the person of our president, the Reverend D.V. Hurst. Outstanding leadership ability is exemplified by the year he served as Student Body President at Sioux Falls College in South Dakota. That same year he graduated cum laude with his bachelor's degree and was listed in *Who's Who Among Students in American Colleges and Universities*, 1947. In 1958 he was president of the Graduate Student Body of Drury College in Springfield, Missouri, from which he was awarded a master's degree.

Rev. Hurst was ordained in 1944 in the South Dakota District and has served on the faculty at both North Central Bible College in Minneapolis, Minnesota, and Central Bible College in Springfield, Missouri.

In 1951 Rev. Hurst became a member of the Assemblies of God international headquarters in Springfield, Missouri, where he served first in the Sunday School Department, later as secretary of the Radio Department and producer-narrator for Revival time, and finally as coordinator of the Spiritual Life-Evangelism Commission of our denomination. Rev. Hurst has written several books published by Gospel Publishing House in addition to speaking at Bible conferences, and traveling in the interest of Northwest College.

Since President Hurst's arrival at Northwest College in 1966, steady growth can be detected in every area of college life. Signs of physical growth are the enlarged cafeteria, the Learning Center and Gray Hall. Academic growth is evidenced through recognition by the Northwest Association of Secondary and High Schools as a Candidate for Accreditation. The Annual Flying Seminar to the Near East and the College Cultural Series, which brings entertaining and informative guests to the campus each quarter, have enriched cultural life at Northwest College.

These developments are not merely products of chance. President Hurst himself put it very well when he said, "Things just don't happen. Young people just don't happen through a college education. Someone dreams for them, plans for them and carries through for them." Putting action to this attitude of fore sight, early in 1970 President Hurst revealed the Master Plan for Northwest College which outlines the school's development through 1985.

A talented administrator, a master in the delicate art of working with people, a warm friend of the student, a man of tremendous stature in his personal walk with God; all of these describe Rev. Hurst, our president and leader. We the students of Northwest College dedicate the 1971 Karisma to you, PRESIDENT D.V. HURST.

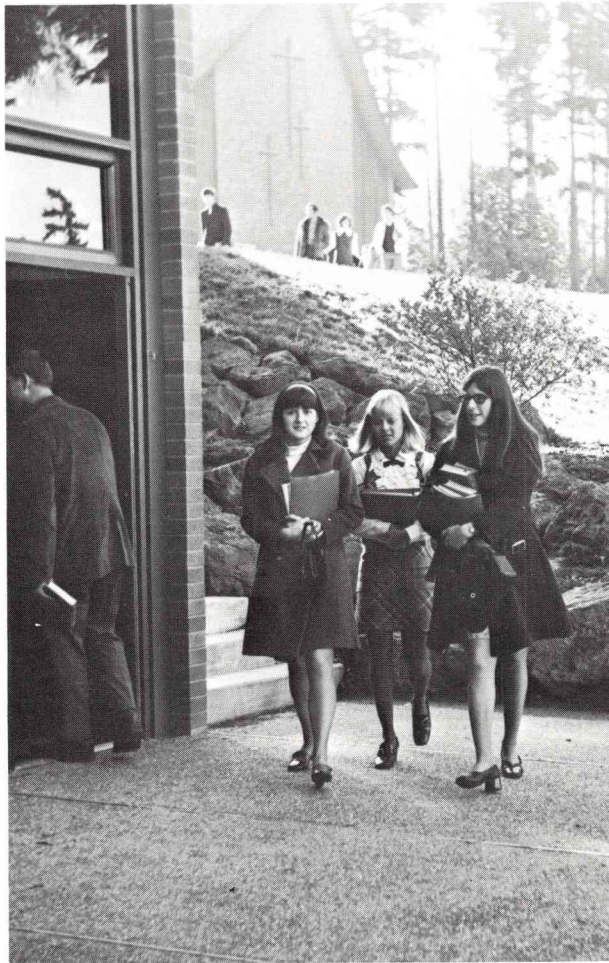

#### “WATER OF LIFE”

On the last, the great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, “If any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink!” To the woman at the well, he said, “Whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst, but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.” Long before Isaiah had cried, “Ho, everyone that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money, come. . .” And Ezekial had seen the river of God and promised, “everything shall live wither the river cometh.”

Water! What a suggestive word it is! What a necessity!

The ancient Greeks--although mistaken--considered it one of the four elements, along with fire, air and earth. Modern man has called it the central material problem of the world, with the result that the Nations of the World have banded together in a ten year study, calling the operation “The International Hydrologic Decade.” There is great fear that the world is running out of water. It appears the masses of men are still deeply concerned about physical water.

But Jesus and Isaiah both spoke of spiritual water. They spoke of a water that satisfied the innermost needs of man, a spiritual water available in abundance. Here was water, they said, that would slake thirst and bring life.

One of the final pictures in the Bible is of “a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.” And there again, the promise is water that brings life!

If the central material problem of man is physical water, it can even more appropriately be said that the central spiritual problem of man is spiritual water--the water of life! And if this be true those who have found it, who have drunk freely and who live thereby must cry aloud, “Ho, here is water. Come. Drink freely and live!”
