MUSICAL OPPORTUNITIES AT NORTHWEST COLLEGE

The College offers a wide variety of musical activities in which its students may participate. The following descriptions are intended to overview the nature and scope of each group, and to indicate how students may become involved.

1. THE CONCERT CHOIR (Kings Choralons). A travelling, forty-voice choir. Membership by audition during the first week of the Fall quarter. Instrumentalists used in this organization. One credit per quarter.

2. THE COLLEGE ENSEMBLE (Maranatha Sounds). A travelling, sixteenvoice ensemble. Membership by audition during the first week of the Fall quarter. One credit per quarter.

NOTE: Prospective rembers of the above two groups sign up for a ten-minute audition time each Fall and are required among other things to sing and (if applicable), play a number of their own choice. An accompanist is available.

3. THE COLLEGE CHOIR. A general concert choral organization open to all students without audition. Performances at the end of each quarter. An excellent opportunity to gain choral experience. One credit per quarter.

4. A CAPPELLA CHOIR. A concert choral organization. Membership by audition. Proformances at the end of each quarter. One credit per quarter.

5. THE CONCERT BAND. Membership by audition. Offered Fall and Spring quarters. Emphasizes serious and sacred music. Performs regularly in chapel services and concerts. One credit per quarter.

6. PEP BAND. Membership by audition. Offered in the Winter quarter. Performs at all home basketball games. One credit per quarter.

7. SUMMER MINISTRY TEAMS. Summer travelling groups of three to five members. Scholarships involved. Selected by jury audition.

8. GOSPEL TEAMS. General ministry groups. Involves ministry in local churches. Summer Ministry Teams are often chosen from these groups.

9. CHAPEL MUSIC MINISTRY. A chapel service is held every day Monday through Friday, with each involving some kind of special music, i.e., vocal or instrumental solos, duets, trios, quartets, ensembles, etc. Songleaders, pianists, and organists are involved in these services.
