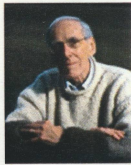

## Peter Hope

COMPOSER

The name of Peter Hope is less known to the general musical public than that of almost any other composer of his generation, but the same certainly cannot be said of his music. His compositions and arrangements were broadcast on an almost daily basis in the 1950s and early 1960s (and his title music for the BBC Television News continued to be used until 1980). The carol arrangements presented tonight, originally created for a 1980 recording on the Philips label with the London Symphony Orchestra, are wonderful examples of Peter Hope's style. Sadly, after the recording session, all the performance materials were destroyed by Philips and largely forgotten. This year Peter searched his archives and found the original pencil scores, and graciously allowed us to reconstruct the arrangements. Tonight will be the first time these arrangements have been performed for a concert audience. We hope you enjoy them!

MUSIC DIRECTOR, RAINIER SYMPHONY

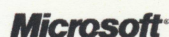
