Auditions for the Concert Choir and Northwest Chorale will be held at the beginning of the school year. Jazz Band will hold auditions during the first class. There are no auditions required for the Wind Ensemble.

The Northwest University Music Department will be offering a new vocal ensemble in the fall called the Chamber Choir. This is a hand selected choir of about forty members.

Northwest University invites you to attend our free upcoming spring events in April. All events are in the Butterfield Chapel and start at 7:30 P.M. The Instrumental Recital is Tuesday the 12th. The Wind Ensemble concert is Friday the 15th. The Vocal Recital is Tuesday the 19th.

The spring choral concert featuring the Concert Choir is Saturday, April 16th at 7:30 P.M. in the Butterfield Chapel. Admission is \$7 adults, \$5 students and seniors. Tickets are available over the phone or at the door. We will also be pre-selling CDs of the choir.

The music department program at Northwest University has over sixty music majors, four full time professors, seven part time instructors, ten adjunct professors, one media director and an administrative assistant.
