## Baccalaureate Service

1. The service is at the BELLEVUE NEIGHBORHOOD CHURCH.

2. The service begins at 3:00 p.m.

3. Roll call will be taken by checking with Mr. Robinson in the foyer. Give him your BOX NUMBER.

4. Except for graduates, faculty and choir, you may sit anywhere in the auditorium.

5. Graduates will be seated in the first four rows on the right-hand side (near the organ).

6. Faculty members will be seated in the first three rows on the left-hand side of the auditorium (near the piano). Actually, the first row will be left vacant, and faculty members will use the second and third rows, although the first three are reserved.

Faculty members will please meet in the C.A. auditorium at 2:45 p.m. so

that the faculty can come in as a group.

7. Choir members will be seated in the choir loft. See Miss Amundsen for instructions.

## Commencement Service

1. Service is at Calvary Temple, at 7:30 p.m., Friday, June 8.

- 2. The Rev. Hardy Steinberg, member of the national Department of Education, is to be the speaker. Invite family and friends. Light refreshments will be served afterward in the lower auditorium.
- 3. Marching practice for NON-GRADUATES will be in the college chapel. All non-graduates will assemble in the chapel on Friday, June 8, at 9:10 a.m. for complete instructions and assignment to places.

Students sit in assigned seats at the graduation exercises.

4. There will be no combined practice for graduates, faculty and directors.

FACULTY and DIRECTORS will meet in the Paul Ness room of Calvary Temple at
7:00 p.m. to receive instructions.

5. Instructions for caps and gowns will be distributed to graduates and faculty

members.

6. Roll will be taken by Mr. Fee when the lines have been formed in the lower auditorium at Calvary Temple. Students will assemble NOT LATER than 7:00 p.m. (This means that the line forms then. If you require preliminary preparations, come earlier.)

Row leaders will wear numbers in the lower auditorium and each is responsible to see that those assigned to his row are in order. Odd-numbered rows come in the EAST aisle; even numbered rows come in the WEST aisle (side nearest the organ),

Row leaders are responsible to report the attendance of their rows to

Mr. Fee.
