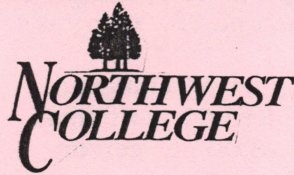

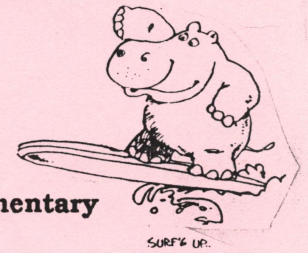
The cut-off date for SCIE 316 and SCIE 317 has been changed from March 5th to March 12th to correlate with Summer School Registration week.
