
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# A PLACE WHERE MINISTRY DEVELOPS


Training ministers who see the spiritual needs of men, however those needs may take shape, is the central point of N.C.'s mission.

Therefore, N.C.'s work still lodges in the heart of its original purpose as stated by its founders in what is now the preamble to N.C.'s Constitution and Bylaws:

- To combine sound scholarship and vital Christian living.
- To study every book of the Bible.
- To gain facility in the basic fields of learning.
- To train pastors and evangelists...in various opportunities for actual ministry.
- To train Christian educators either as full-time workers or as "lay" workers in their home churches.
- To foster missionary interests and help missionary candidates prepare.
- To develop music talents and prepare those who wish to devote their lives to music ministry.
- To assist in preparation of chaplains, teachers, nurses, educators, etc.
- To encourage all to be filled with the spirit, to live consistent lives, and to win men to Christ.
- To help all to form wholesome intellectual, social and spiritual attitudes as basis for citizenship in democracy and for active Christian service.
- To make a distinctive contribution to Christian higher education through its curricular structure.

How interesting to review the heart of the preamble of N.C.'s guiding document--its foundation for being!

How securely N.C., as it is today, rests on these under-pinnings! Those who "dreamed, prayed and worked" N.C. into existence placed it on a sure foundation of purpose. Those who

N.C. is doing that!


There is no other college in the entire Northwest of our nation quite like N.C....in its spiritual emphasis and in its academic structure.

### CERTIFICATE IN CHRISTIAN STUDIES

The Certificate in Christian Studies is a one academic year program designed to provide YOU with an opportunity, within the college setting, to expand YOUR knowledge of the Bible and the basic Christian beliefs. It will enrich and enhance YOUR Christian life and enable YOU to better serve in the ministries of the local church.

### ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE

Northwest College seeks to provide an opportunity to begin YOUR college studies in a Christian environment. The program encourages both academic and spiritual growth in preparation for YOUR future educational and vocational goals. The College believes that such an education is unique and available.

Northwest is accredited by both the American Association of Bible College and the Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges. This allows for the transfer of credits to other institutions of higher learning in either biblical or secular studies. YOU are encouraged to include in your degree program as many of the receiving institution's requirements as possible, and to include in YOUR program an emphasis in a subject area that relates to YOUR vocational or educational goals.


### **DIPLOMA**


Northwest recognizes that not all students who would desire a biblical and ministerial education will fit into the traditional setting of the Bachelor of Arts programs. Some due to circumstance, such as a late in life call to ministry, will not feel the need to give four years to preparation for ministry. Since it requires three academic years the diploma program is designed to aid YOU in ministerial preparation while requiring limited "general education" courses.


### **BACHELOR OF ARTS DEGREE**

Northwest offers four-year Bachelor of Arts degrees in nine majors. All are accredited by both the Northwest Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges and the American Association of Bible Colleges. As a result, the Bachelor of Arts degree at Northwest has not only a strong academic emphasis, but also has at its core in all majors a Biblical and Theological focus that will prepare YOU to provide needed ministries in the local church. It is the integration of learning that makes the Northwest College Bachelor of Arts program valuable and enriching, regardless of YOUR choice of profession upon graduation.

















# THE MAJORS AT NORTHWEST COLLEGE ARE DESIGNED TO PREPARE YOU FOR SERVICE AND LIFE:

### **BIBLICAL LITERATURE**

The Biblical Literature major will (1) aid YOU in acquiring a broad knowledge of the background, content, and meaning of the Bible and (2) develop skills for further study and communication of the Bible.

### BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE

The Behavioral Science major will provide the foundation for entrance into helping ministries such as the ministry of Pastoral Care and prepare YOU to enter graduate professional education as necessary for fulfilling the requirements for ministries such as Chaplaincy.

### CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

The major in Christian Education provides YOU with the background necessary to serve the local church in the variety of Christian education ministries; minister of Christian Education, adult ministries, children's pastor and others.

### **ELEMENTARY EDUCATION**

The major in Elementary Education will provide YOU with the knowledge and competency to work effectively in both public and private educational settings. The major requirements lead to Washington State Teacher Certification (K-8th grade).

### MISSIONS

The major in Missions will develop YOUR understanding and appreciation for the mission of the Church in worldwide evangelism and equip YOU to engage in cross-cultural missions. The major will prepare YOU to meet the ministry requirements for missionary appointment.

### PASTORAL MINISTRIES

The Pastoral Ministries major will prepare YOU for the ministry of pastor-teacher by providing training in Biblical and theological studies and applied ministries skills, and by aiding YOU to develop a philosophy of ministry for pastoral service.

### **RELIGION AND PHILOSOPHY**

The major in Religion and Philosophy will provide YOU with the educational background necessary for graduate education in a seminary or graduate school of religion that will be necessary in order to enter ministries such as military chaplaincies and Biblical and theological teaching.

### SACRED MUSIC

The Sacred Music major will enable YOU to develop YOUR talents for the ministry of music in the local church, either in the leadership of the music ministries of the church or in specialized performance skills used for ministry to the church.

### YOUTH MINISTRIES

The major in Youth Ministries will prepare YOU for ministry to youth in the local church and in the community by developing and integrating the Biblical, theological and psychological foundations necessary to actively minister to and evangelize-disciple junior high, high school and college students.

### **GRANTS**

Northwest College is accredited by both AABC and the NASC – this means that our students are eligible for government grants in aid. These are significant in the overall pack-

age of many students who meet the financial need requirements. For example, the PELL GRANT (Basic Federal Grant) provides up to \$2100.00 per year. Other types available include the Washington State, and Oregon state, need grants; and the Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant.

### JOBS

The Greater Seattle area provides a great number of job opportunities in a competitive salary market. Current student jobs pay between \$4.00 and \$8.00 with an average of \$5.50, based upon experience and the type of job. Northwest actively helps in placement through the JOB SEARCH office.
