TRANSFER OF CREDITS

Students who have questions concerning the transfer of credits are advised to confer with the Dean of Education or the Registrar.

The Registrar's office has made a tabulation of some 20 regionally accredited liberal arts colleges or universities where NC credits have been recognized or where statements of policy indicate the possibility of transfer.

In this respect we would like to share with our students some good news concerning the prospect of broadened recognition of NC credits as a result of a new published listing by the UW in the forthwoming AACRAO publication, <u>Credit Given</u>. This will indicate that NC will have the same rating with the University as new Junior Colleges in the state. It is expected that this development will open new doors of possibility for our Junior College students who are pursuing transfer programs here at NC.

Transfer of credits between institutions is not usually possible unless the academic performance at both colleges is satisfactory ("C" of better).
