FACTS ABOUT THE NORTHWEST COLLEGE LIBRARY

Development of the library began about 1950, 15 years ago.

The library now includes slightly over 16,000 cataloged books, and regularly receives about 130 magazines.

Students borrow 50 to 55 books or other items apiece during an average school year. This is the highest rate per student of any Assemblies of God school and one of the highest rates for any institution in the Accrediting Association of Bible Colleges.

The present library quarters, which are temporary, will seat 70 students at one time and will hold about 18,000 books.

An effort is now being made to increase library holdings to about 30,000 volumes over a five-year period, beginning this year.
