SELECTIVE SERVICE:

Selective Service is currently interpreting "full-time" student status to mean that academic load which enables the student to earn a Bachelor's degree within a consecutive four-year span of time. This effectively means that young men of draft-age should carry at least FIFTEEN CREDITS PER QUARTER in order to meet this criterion for deferment. Slight variations from this figure will be permitted IF the student is making normal progress towards completion of his academic program on time. Projected in terms of yearly accomplishment it means that students should complete not less than 45 credits of work creditable towards their college programs.

Our young men students are warned to keep their academic loads up to full-time according to this definition of the term.

TITHING:

Concerning student's tithes to the College it would be well to be informed. The Northwest District of the Assemblies of God has recommended that students pay their tithes into the Student Body and Missionary Society funds in order to effect the work of these groups in aiding the work extension of the kingdom of God at home and abroad.
