- 2nd Period: Pray for Jean La Cossack's parents who work with the Gypsies in France. They are building a center which includes a Bible school and primary school.
- 3rd Period: In the Congo - five national ministers are being held captive by a backslider in assemblies of God missionary. He is threatening to kill them.
- 4th Period: Pray for the Guitierrez in the jungles of Peru. Some members have not been located, and it is feared that they have been killed by guerrilla fighters.
- 5th Period: Missionaries in Indonesia have a definite need of our prayers because of the violence and free-floing bloodshed that has continued following the communist attempt to take over the government. It has been understood that if the communists had succeeded, every white missionary would have been placed on a top priority list for execution. Though they didn't succeed, the missionaries still need our prayers desperately.
