FROM THE REGISTRAR:

1. Some students have inquired about temporary reductions in academic loads to a part-time level. Selective Service advises us that such students automatically lose their student deferments.
2. In view of a substantial increase in the number of applicants seeking admission to Northwest College for next fall, it appears that some steps will be needed to pre-enroll our present students who expect to return in order to determine space availability.

This procedure will also facilitate new Selective Service Requirements for men students for whom the school must submit a certification following the end of the current school year.

Pre-enrollment forms will be distributed to students on the day of the academic workshop which will be announced soon. Please be prepared accordingly.
