Student Parking - Students are required to park only in the areas designated for Student Parking and only in the area that they have been assigned. Parking decals are here and will be distributed. A campus security officer, Mr. Bill Bresko, has been hired and will be issuing tickets for traffic violations. He will also be checking the security of the campus buildings and observing for irregular activities on the campus. Your cooperation in this matter will be appreciated.

Campus Bulletin Boards - Announcements or posters for campus bulletin boards in the dormitories, Student Union Building, and other student bulletin boards must be cleared in the office of the Dean of Students before they are posted.

Faculty Reception of New Students - The Faculty Reception of New Students will be held on this Friday from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m. at the Northwest Pavilion. All freshmen and transfer students are cordially invited to attend. Married students are asked to bring their wives. Please wear your name tags and find a place in the reception line no later than 7:30 p.m.

Student Handbook - All students are required to read the Student Handbook within the first five days of class. The green student agreement card must be signed and turned in to the receptionist's desk. The deadline for reading of the Student Handbook is Tuesday, October 3.

Church attendance - As noted on page 7 of the Student Handbook, "Within three Sundays after enrollment, students are to make a choice of a church home they will attend while in College. A change from one assigned church to another is not permitted except by Permission of the Dean of Students.
