To clarify the College's rules on dropping courses, the Registrar's Office submits the following:

1. Last day to drop a course with a W (a neutral mark) if not passing, is (was) October 24.
2. Last day to drop a course officially under any circumstances (except if withdrawing from college) will be November 3.

### CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE

Health and Accident Insurance as provided by the College is required of all full-time students except if the student is already covered by a personal policy or by his or her parent's policy. However, if in the future, the accounting office will require that in the case of outside coverage, the student must submit evidence of coverage by presenting a card issued by the insurance company or a letter from his or her parents certifying coverage.
