### CLARIFICATION ON SELECTIVE SERVICE AND THE LOTTERY

The new lottery system adopted by the Selective Service System has only to do with the order of induction of eligible young men and has nothing to do with student deferments. It is still necessary to satisfactorily pursue a full-time course of instruction in order to retain student deferments. Students who drop out of college or drop below full-time status in college will automatically lose their deferments and will be reclassified. Notwithstanding the "gamble" of not being inducted under the lottery plan, it is urged that young men subject to military service carefully preserve their student status so that they will not lose their student deferments. Once lost, it is still a matter of discretion with local boards as to whether or not a deferment will be reinstated.
