FROM THE REGISTRAR

Consideration is being given to a numbering system for fall quarter registration. The numbers would be assigned to upperclassmen in the order that they submit re-enrollment and reservation applications this spring, or in the following weeks. A given series of numbers will be tied to a time-block for registration next fall. A pre-registration scheduling of numbers and times will then be published and sent to students who have filed return-enrollment reservations.

New students and upperclassmen who may have failed to gain a registration appointment for the first day of registration will be registered in order with freshmen on the second day of registration under the plan. New students will be assigned registration numbers on the basis of the order in which they applied to come to the college.

Students now on campus will be given an initial opportunity to file return reservation forms in chapel on Wednesday, May 27. Those not filing the form on that date may do so at the Registrar's office at any time thereafter and will be assigned a registration number in sequence. All students will be notified of their registration order numbers.

1970-71 CATALOGS

All students now on campus who are planning to return next fall are invited to pick up at the Registrar's office a copy of the 1970-71 catalog. Of prime importance in the catalog is the college calendar for the 1970-71 school year. Attention is called to a change in the pattern of the Fall Registration dates.
