Friday chapel services are devoted to the missionary council. David T. Scott, missionary to Peru, visited the college and brought a challenging missionary message to the student body.





LIBRARY SOURCE OF INFORMATION AND KNOWLEDGE




Mr. Peter Ahlstrom is the Librarian at N.B.C. and is a graduate of the College.
