SELECTIVE SERVICE:

It is still necessary for 18 year old men to register for the draft, and to be classified by their local draft boards even though boards are not now drafting young men. The current law requires young men to register within 30 days of their 18th birthday. Only that section of this law which deals with the authority to actually induct has been suspended for the current period of time. Registrations may be effected through the Office of the Registrar here on campus.
