## STUDENT ACCOUNTS:

A 6% carrying charge for the spring quarter is applied to all accounts not paid in full at the beginning of classes. However, the 6% is refunded on accounts paid and receipted in our office through April 8. A 3% refund is made on all accounts paid from April 9-23 inclusive. After that date, no carrying charges will be refunded.

#### FINANCIAL AID:

All students (except seniors) are encouraged to make an application for a Basic Educational Opportunity Grant. Forms are available through the Financial Aids Officer in Ness Hall. The provisions of eligibility have been broadened until it is feasible for all students to make application. In fact, it is now a prerequisite to make application for other forms of financial aid.

Students needing and desiring Federal Aid in the form of a National Direct Student Loan, Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, or the College Work/Study, are requested to submit their application to the College and send off the appropriate Confidential Statement as soon as possible. Certain allocations of state aid are determined by this. All of the necessary forms are available at the office -- act now -- the effectiveness of the program is dependent upon your early cooperation.
