ATTENTION DRIVERS:

The College Vehicle Code is intended for the convenience, security, and safety of all. It is being enforced now and applies to all students who own or operate a vehicle. With over 400 vehicles on campus, strict compliance is essential. Citations are issued when a violation occurs. The following conditions prevail as to enforcement of the code:

1. Citations may be challenged within 48 hours at the Dean of Students Office.
2. Fines will be paid in cash within 7 days.
3. Fined not paid in 7 days will be added to the student's account with a surcharge.
4. 3 citations within one quarter will result in automatic disciplinary action.
5. Vehicles illegally parked may be towed away at the owners expense.

Please consult the code as received when you register. If you have questions or special concerns, consult the Dean of Students Office.

ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS:

Policy requires that students pay cash for their books and supplies. The only ones who should apply for an exception to this are those who receive a Federal Aid or Loan award which covers the cost of their books.

STUDENT ACCOUNTS - PAYMENT POLICY:

Students using the Deferred Pay Plan must pay a carrying charge of 6% for the quarter, with the provision for a 6% refund if paid within 15 days, 3% within 15-30 days.

CAFETERIA:

The Cafeteria Cashier is required to punch the meal ticket or collect cash for each student each meal. In the case of a lost ticket students should replace it immediately since the above rule will apply. The 24 hour grace period no longer applies.
