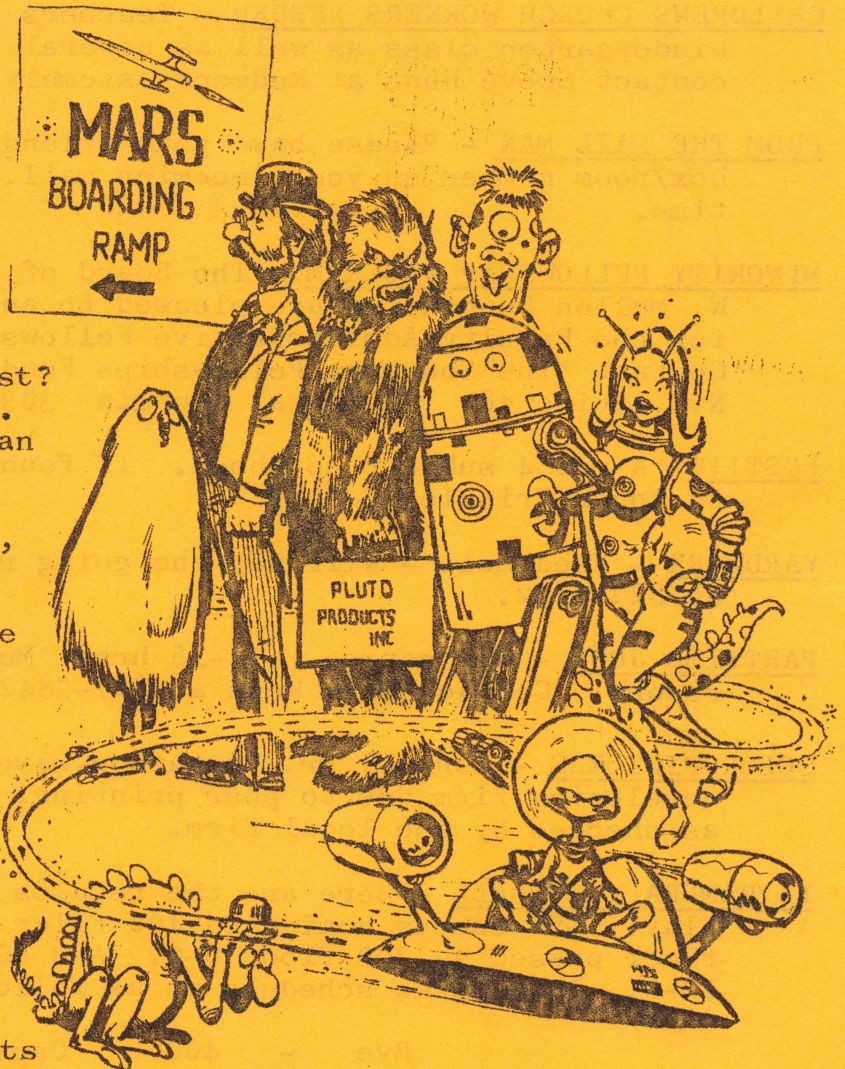
CLEP TESTS - The new shipment
