SOCCER - A meeting for all Soccer players will be held Tuesday, Jan. 17th after chapel in the chapel overflow. It is important that you attend.

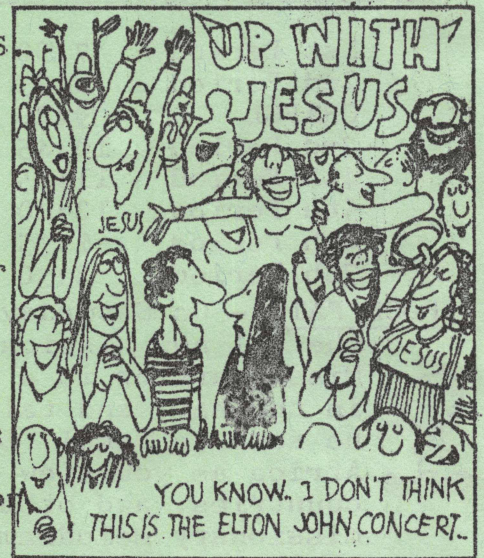
