Advice to college students: Be kind to your parents. After they get through paying to send you, you're all they'll have.

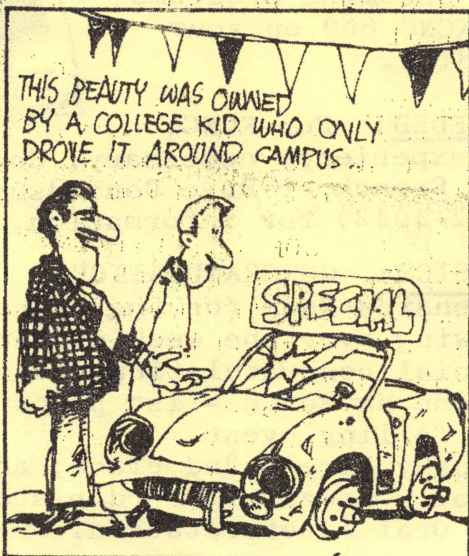
U.W. - Planning Transfer? The U.W. has announced a new policy for admitting transfer students. Admission will be on a point system, the points being derived from H.S. GPA, college GPA, and entrance test scores. The only students given admission without test scores are those who have at least 75 transferable college credits and have maintained a scholastic record which suggests he will earn B-average grades at the university.
