After May 10th fee is \$8.00 per couple and \$5.00 per individual without partner.

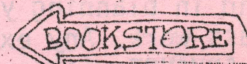

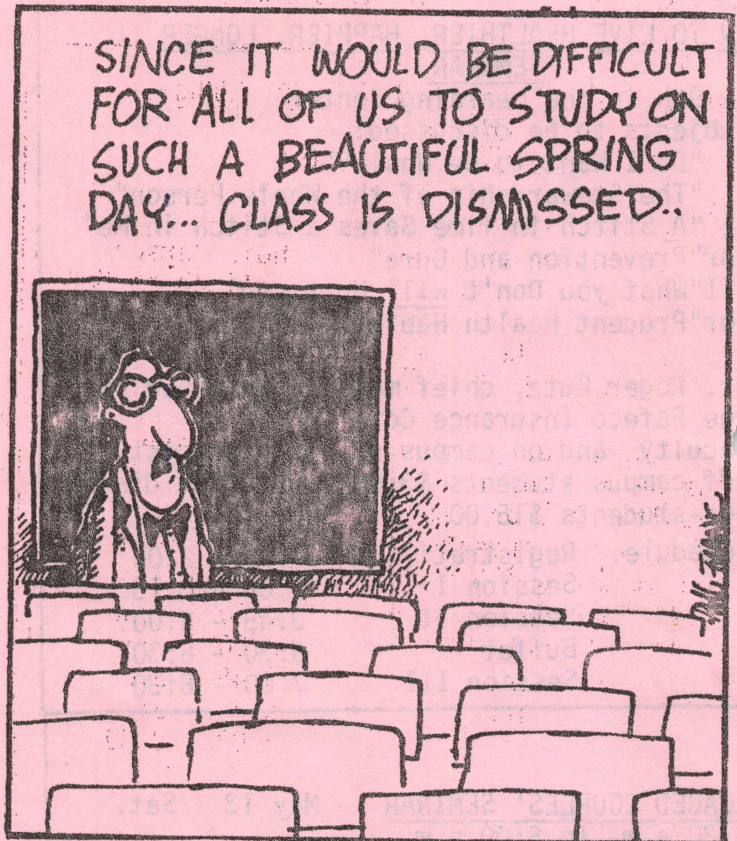
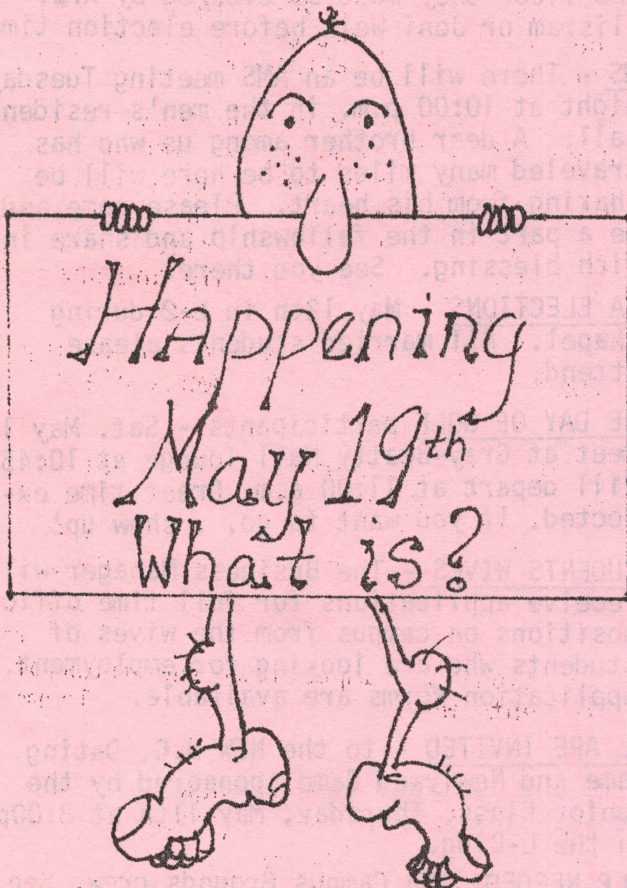
INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY NEXT FALL:
