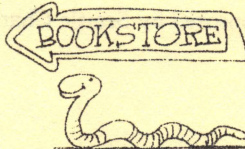

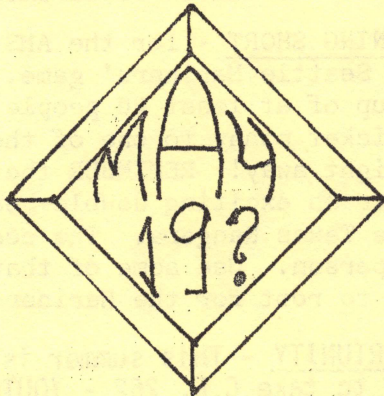
SUMMER OPPORTUNITY - On Campus Grounds crew. See Martin Dormier or Mr. Hodges. Work schedule can be flexible.
