WARNING: Students must take responsibility for their attendance of classes. More than two weeks of absences from a class will result in a UW grade ("unofficial withdrawal" with a loss of credit) for the course. Regular withdrawal from the course (with grade of W) must be ef-.fected before excessive absences have accumulated, if at all. Petitions for change of UW to W will be honored only if the student can demonstrate that he had intended to withdraw through the Registrar's Office but was prevented from doing so in time because of an extended illness or similar emergency.

CANDIDATES FOR GRADUATION: It is the responsibility of those planning to graduate in May, 1979 to file with the Registrar's office an application for graduation. At the same time they should set up an appointment for an audit of their records. Most candidates for graduation will have taken care of this task during Fall Quarter Registration.
