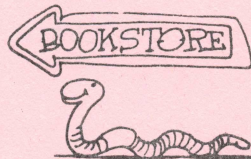

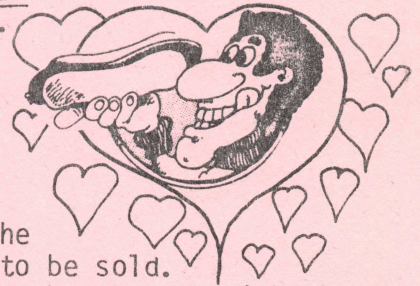
#### COMING SOON. . . .
