MEMORIAL DAY LIBRARY HOURS - 9:00 am-10:00pm

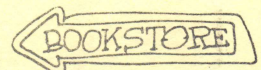

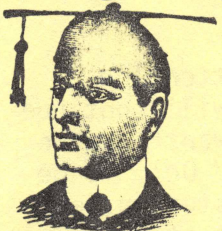
