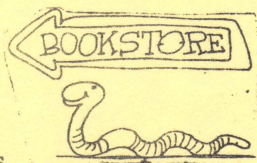

Marian Hood requests that all of her books, records, and tapes be returned to her. Leave them with Jan Flateau in the Music Center.

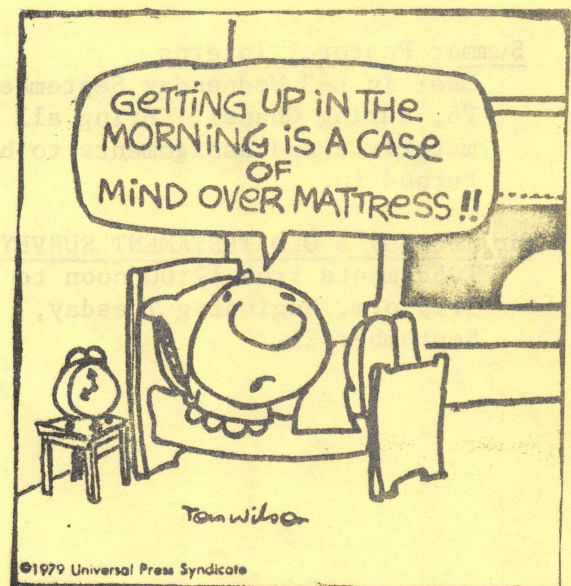

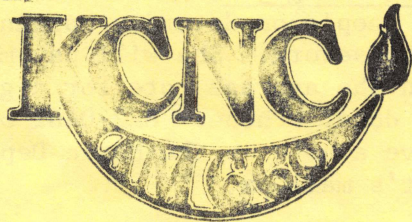
