

FRESHMAN CLASS OFFICER NOMINATIONS!!!

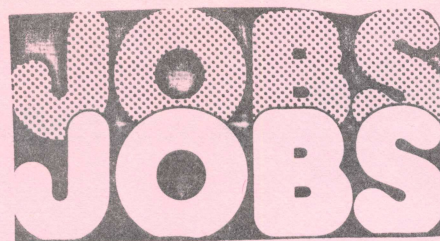
Freshman be thinking of who you want
