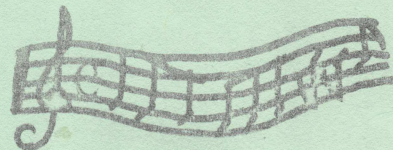

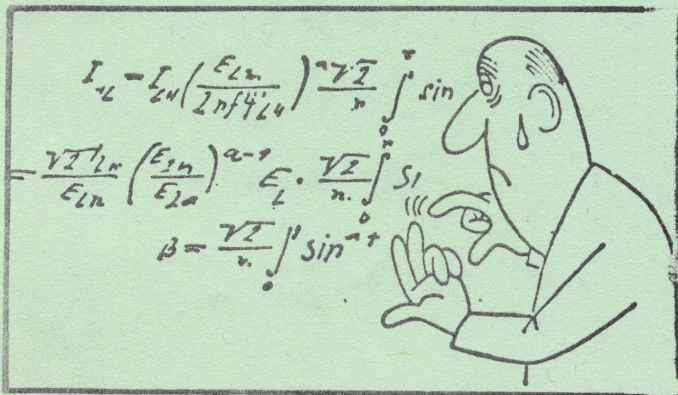
Pictures from last Spring Quarter are on sale in the area in front of the counter in the Registrar's Office for 25¢ each. This price just covers the cost of the picture.
