All students planning to GRADUATE this year need to sign up for an audit in the Registrar's Office. Audits will be given Oct. 8-19.

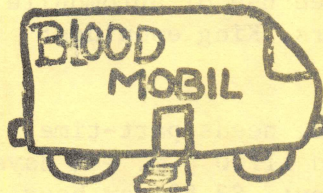
