Men: 400 floor, Thursday Oct. 25, 9:45.

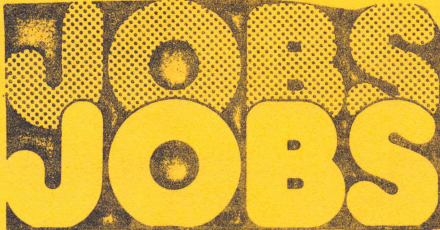
