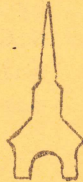
ATTENTION! Is your account paid in full?

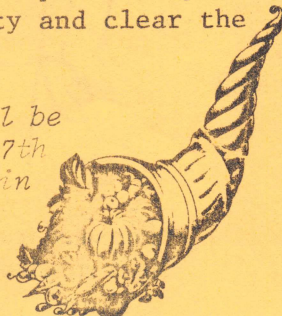
