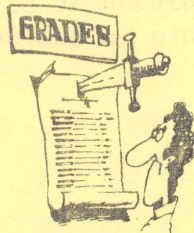

This Saturday Night at 7:30 p.m. Neighborhood Church will be having a drama group called Royal Diadem. A one act special for \$2.00.

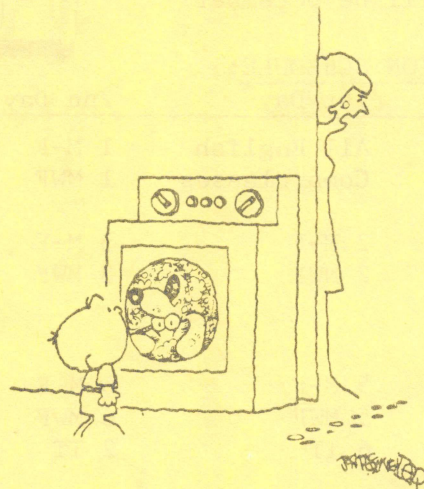
Intramural Football Results:
