Is your account paid in full? Good! All deferred balances were due in full by February 8. Any outstanding balances should be paid immediately.

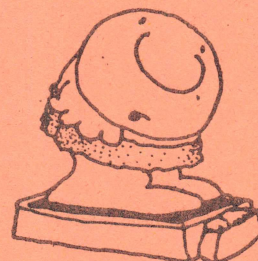
